The Association of Fundraising Professionals (AFP) is committed to advancing philanthropy by encouraging people and organizations to practice effective and ethical fundraising. The core activities of the Chapter include education, mentoring, training, advocacy, and encouraging the pursuit of professional growth and development. The Northeast Iowa Chapter helps fundraisers serve their communities through services to its members, and we would like to encourage you to consider joining this group of fundraising professionals.

Each year the Northeast Iowa AFP Chapter awards a number of scholarships in the categories listed below.

Scholarship recipients are required to provide materials to the chapter from the course, conference, or workshop attended. Recipients may be invited to provide a presentation to the chapter and this invitation will be extended with the understanding that the scholarship recipient has the option of declining such an invitation without repercussion.

Each scholarship recipient must provide service to the Chapter for one year in a role of their choosing (i.e. board member, committee member, officer, etc.).

Available Scholarships Include:

- **General Chapter Scholarship:** Individuals may submit a request using the Northeast Iowa Chapter's Scholarship Application Form. Scholarship funds will be made available for all membership levels and Chapter and National AFP events. Each year the board of directors will approve a scholarship fund within the annual budget, limiting the maximum funds available for all scholarship awards during the fiscal year. The designated committee will have full discretion of the amount and type of each scholarship awarded, provided the total amount of scholarships awarded does not exceed the board approved limit in a given fiscal year.
- **Chamberlain Scholarship:** One scholarship of a registration fee to the annual AFP ICON Conference. The AFP Foundation for Philanthropy will directly pay the funds to AFP IHQ for registration. Recipients will be required to pay \$10 and their own travel expenses. Applicants must never have attended an international conference as a registered participant. Deadline: October 15. *Chapter reporting form and registration form due to IHQ by October 31 each year, for the following year's conference.*
- **CFRE/ACFRE Exam Scholarship:** One scholarship of \$75 toward the CFRE/ACFRE exam. The chapter will pay \$75 directly to the scholarship recipient after the individual provides proof of payment for the exam in total.
